RE: Amherst Avenue Raised Crosswalk

Please be advised that starting January 10, 2024, Think Pavers Construction will begin work on the Amherst Avenue Raised Crosswalk Project on Amherst Avenue between 35th Avenue and 34th Avenue. This work will take approximately two (2) weeks to finish. Please do not park on Amherst Avenue between 35th Avenue and 34th Avenue from 8 am until 5 pm each day from January 10, 2024, until January 24, 2024, or until work is completed and the traffic detour has been removed. We advise having your car moved from your driveway each day before 8 am and out of the work area if you live within the work zone. Trash and recycling pick up will remain uninterrupted. During this project, traffic may be detoured south bound on Amherst Avenue at 36th Avenue and northbound on Amherst Avenue at 34th Avenue. We appreciate your patience. 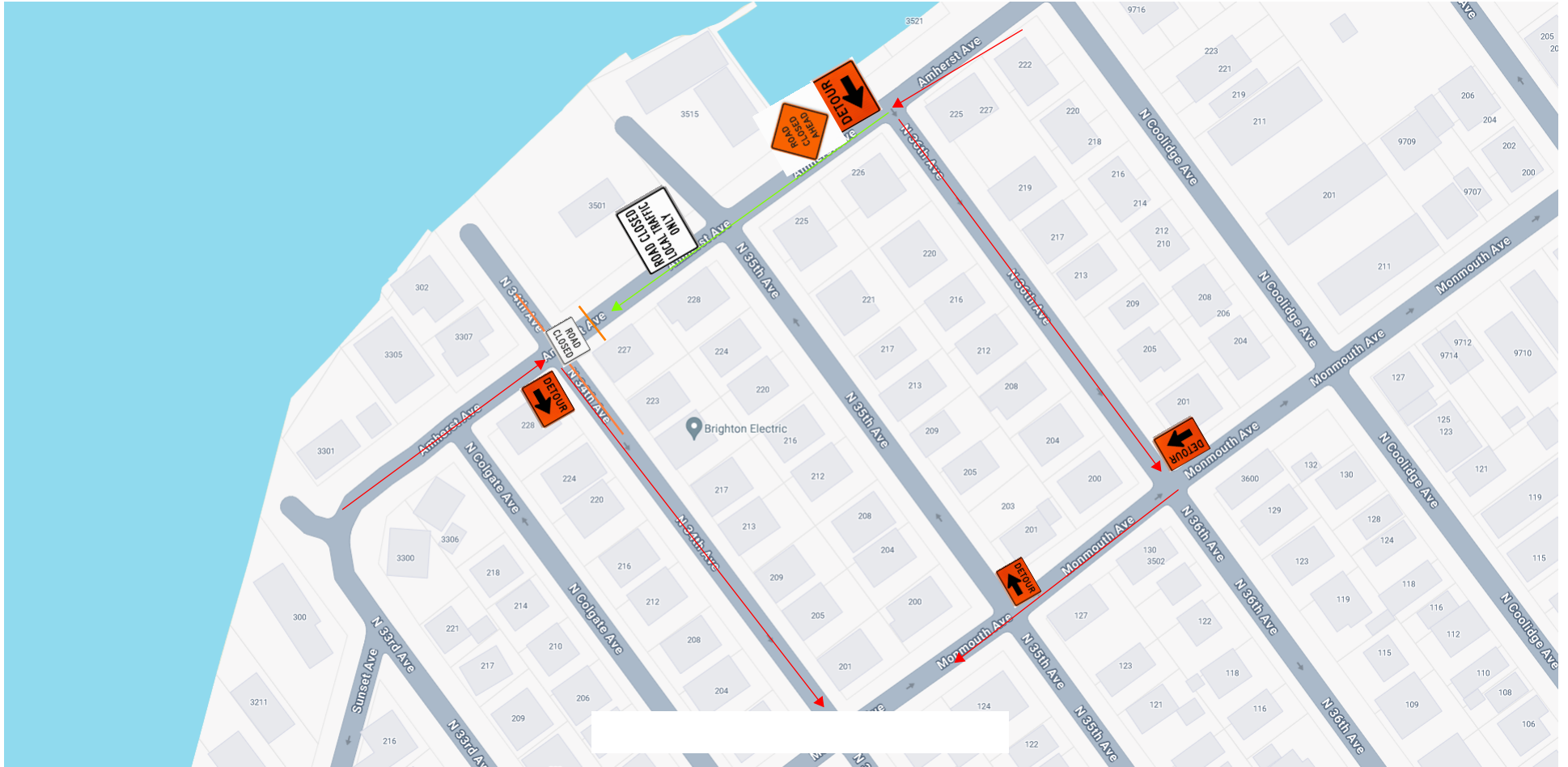
