

**BOROUGH OF LONGPORT
ORDINANCE NO. 2018-11**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBCHAPTER 147-19 PUBLIC UTILITIES
PERTAINING TO UNDERGROUND ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS
OF CHAPTER 147- STREETS AND SIDEWALKS OF THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF LONGPORT, ATLANTIC COUNTY, NEW JERSEY**

Purpose: The purpose of this Ordinance is to mandate that all underground installation of electrical services shall be open trenched and not drilled. The reason for this requirement is that it allows the Municipal Building Department, specifically the Municipal Electrical SubCode Inspector, the ability to physically inspect to assure that the conduit has been installed to the regulatory depth for safety purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT that:

SECTION I: Subsection 147-19 Underground service connections. The following is added at the end of the existing paragraph:

All underground electrical services within the paved cartway of any Street shall be installed in open trenches to permit inspection by the Municipal Code SubCode Official. No trench shall be backfilled until inspected and approved. All excavation and restoration shall be in accordance with Subchapter 147-3. Upon installation of the electrical service, an as-built scaled plan of said installation from utility pole to dwelling shall be provided to the Building Department and Public Works Department.

SECTION II: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such inconsistencies, are hereby repealed. Should any section, subsection, clause, or portion of this Ordinance be adjudged by a Court of competent jurisdiction as invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by Law.
