ACUA collects residential Trash & Bulk every Monday.

**Recycling Day:** please keep trash & recycling 10' apart  
 Jan—May 6: recycling is every other week  
 May 20—Sept 9: recycling is every week  
 Sept 23—December: recycling is every other week

**Public Works Yard Waste Collection**  
 Jan—March: yard waste is every other week  
 April—November: yard waste is every week  
 December: yard waste is every other week

**Food Drive-Dec 2nd:** Place food donation next to your recycling.

## DISPOSAL INFORMATION

**BULKY WASTE:** 2 items per trash day including furniture, carpet and mattresses. Carpet must be cut into 4' lengths, rolled & tied (1 roll = 1 bulk item). **No construction waste.**

**ELECTRONICS:** Electronics are collected every Monday by Public Works. Call 609-823-2731 x. 109 to schedule a pick up.

**METALS:** Metals are collected every Monday by Public Works. *Refrigerators and air conditioners must have Freon removed prior to collection.* Call 609-823-2731 x. 109 to schedule a pick up.

**LATEX PAINT:** Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. [acua.com/paint](http://acua.com/paint)

**BATTERIES:** Alkaline batteries can go in the trash. Rechargeable, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium, silver-oxide and lead-acid batteries should be taken to our Household Hazardous Waste drop-offs. [acua.com/hhw](http://acua.com/hhw)

**SHREDDED PAPER:** Cannot be recycled curbside, but can be brought to ACUA's Drop-off in EHT. [acua.com/rcdropoffs](http://acua.com/rcdropoffs)

## YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Collected by Public Works: 609-823-2731  
Residents are required to use biodegradable bags or containers.

- No hay/straw bales, bamboo, cornstalks, seagrass;
- No dirt, sand or rocks;
- 4' length and 8" diameter limit for branches/wood;
- Branches must be tied in bundles; and
- No plastic bags — use biodegradable Kraft bags.
