Alternate Borough Solicitor Agnellini, Administrator Porter, Chief Culmone, CFO Kelly, Engineer Dennis, and Municipal Clerk Kyle also present.

Mayor Russo stated the location of the emergency exits and discussed opportunities for public comment.

Administrator Porter:

Administrator Porter discussed union contract agreements. He said that he had tentative agreements with the police and lifeguard associations. He explained that he hoped to have resolutions ready for the February 15th Commission Meeting. He also discussed an ordinance on the agenda for introduction that would amend the administrator's hours from '32 hours' to 'averaging 32 hours.'

Administrator Porter also noted that at the previous Commission Meeting the Governing Body gave him permission to offer a year renewal for the beach vending license. He said that the vendor declined the option to renew. He added that the Borough is planning on having a bid opening for the beach vending license on February 7th at 2 pm.

Alternate Borough Solicitor Agnellini:

Alternate Borough Solicitor Agnellini had nothing further to report.

Borough Engineer Dennis:

Engineer Dennis provided an update on several construction projects. He explained that there was a delay with the Atlantic Avenue road construction project as the contractor was waiting for structures to be delivered. He added that the tentative start was scheduled for next week. He added that a meeting had been held with the contractor to discuss traffic control. He added that construction related signage has gone up on Atlantic Avenue.

Engineer Dennis explained that the work on Monmouth Avenue was beginning to wind down and that everything east of Yarmouth Avenue had been completed. He noted that there was some additional work to be completed on Yarmouth and 32nd avenues. He added that work continues at the water tower, including structural and interior work.

He provided an update on Well House #4 adding that the Borough is waiting for Atlantic City Electric to complete an upgrade to the electrical service. He said that the delay was due to some issues Atlantic City Electric was having with equipment. He discussed a contingency plan that, if needed, would help to keep the project completed on time. Engineer Dennis also discussed the 36th Avenue bayside bulkhead repair. He said that the first round of permit comments from the NJ Department of Environmental Protection were favorable. Based on this, he hoped to be able to go forward with project bidding soon so it could be ready for award at the February meeting. Mayor Russo questioned if there were any recent water pressure issues with the ongoing renovation of the water tower. Engineer Dennis noted that he did not hear of any.

Library Director, Ricky Gerhardt, provided an update on upcoming programs at the Longport Public Library.

<u>Commissioner Leeds:</u> Commissioner Leeds asked if a meeting had been set with Jim Rutala to discuss available grant funding.
