A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LONGPORT TO ENTER INTO THE NEW JERSEY STATE DISABILITY BENEFIT

WHEREAS, the Borough of Longport currently does not offer a disability benefit to the municipal employees; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Longport is desirous of entering into the New Jersey State Disability Plan effective January 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the NJ State Disability Plan, the employee contribution rate for 2016 was .2% of the first \$32,600 paid to the worker and the employer rate was .5% of the first \$32,600 paid to the worker. 2017 rates have not been set but it is anticipated that there will only be a slight increase; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Body of the Borough of Longport wishes to enter into the New Jersey State Disability Plan as of January 1, 2017 to be funded through quarterly contributions.
