**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION REPORT
WITH THE N.J. DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AS IT PERTAINS TO
THE PUBLIC WORKS COMPLEX 31st Avenue and Devon Avenue**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Longport was notified in 2013 by New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) that they were unable to locate a formal close out letter from the Underground Storage Tank Removal Contractor who performed the removal of certain underground fuel tanks at the Public Works Complex in 1998; and

WHEREAS, a review of the files in the Public Works Department did not result in any copies of reports or other information required by the NJDEP; and

WHEREAS, in order to avoid potential fines from the NJDEP, the Borough employed **Brinkerhoff Environmental** in 2014 to undertake a Remedial Investigation of the site in order to provide the NJDEP that information that they requested; and

WHEREAS, as a result of that investigation, it was determined that one of the samples within the backfill material contained a contaminant while the remainder of the backfill material and surrounding natural material showed no sign of contamination; and

WHEREAS, between 2014 and 2018 **Brinkerhoff Environmental** performed additional testing of the site and met with NJDEP Officials as to the potential resolution of the existing minor contamination; and

WHEREAS, **Brinkerhoff Environmental** has prepared a Remedial Investigation Report dated June 19, 2018 indicating that there is recommended 'no further action' based on the fact that there is no impact to groundwater; the native material was not affected; and the area of concern is under existing asphalt pavement; and

WHEREAS, **Brinkerhoff Environmental** has prepared and is requesting that the Borough execute the attached **Authorization to submit a Remedial Phase Report through NJDEP Online** and a **Cover/Certification Form** in order to submit the Final Remedial Investigation Report to the NJDEP.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Longport that the Municipal Engineer, as the Borough's Representative in this matter is hereby authorized to sign the respective forms.
