WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has cited the Borough for this failure to test and offered a penalty settlement agreement requiring the payment of \$1250 penalty;

WHEREAS, The Borough Solicitor has reviewed the proposed agreement and penalty and recommends that the Borough execute the agreement and pay the penalty.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body of the Borough of Longport hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute and deliver the proposed settlement agreement and pay the offered penalty of \$1250.
