## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN EMERGENCY 'NO PARKING' AREA, AND DETOURING TRAFFIC OF DURING THE 2019 MEMORIAL DAY PARADE

**WHEREAS**, the American Legion Post 469- John A. Kuzmann Memorial will hold a Memorial Day Parade on May 27, 2019 that will utilize various streets in the Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, conducting a parade necessitates special traffic regulations on the various streets as listed below; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 39:197.3, a Municipality has the right to permit special traffic regulations when circumstances of this type dictate its necessity.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commissioners of the Borough of Longport that it hereinafter authorizes the following temporary special traffic regulations, including but not limited to the closing and detouring of traffic during parade activities & the enforcement of the below stated road closures which shall be implemented by the Longport Police Department in the Borough of Longport, Atlantic County, New Jersey:

No Parking Signs and Road Closures are ordered beginning at 9:00 AM on Monday, May 27<sup>-</sup>2019, as follows:

26<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Atlantic Avenue to the Bay Bulkhead (Both Sides of the Street) All of Absequam Avenue (Both Sides of the Street) 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Absequam Avenue to Atlantic Avenue (Both Sides of the Street) Oberon Avenue from 26<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 28<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Both Sides of the Street)

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that prohibition of parking shall expire upon completion of the aforesaid event.
