**AUTHORIZING WORK TO  
FALASCA MECHANICAL OF VINELAND, N.J.  
FOR REPAIRS TO HVAC IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, one (1) informal quote and one no response were received by the Administrator from Falasca Mechanical.; and

**WHEREAS**, upon review of said response by the Municipal Administrator, it was determined that **Falasca Mechanical** provided the most responsible proposal, price and other factors being considered, including considering the time sensitivity of this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Administrator and are recommending award to Falasca Mechanical of Vineland, N.J. for the Total Amount of **\$16,760.00** as stated in their Proposal dated April 10, 2020.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Longport Borough Board of Commissioners that the aforementioned recommendation is hereby accepted and that said Governing Body hereby awards a Contract to the only responsible responder, price and other factors being considered, **Falasca Mechanical** of Vineland, N.J. for the repairs to HVAC in the Police Department, for the Total Amount of **\$16,760.00** as stated in their Proposal dated April 10, 2020; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Municipal Chief Finance Officer is hereby directed to issue the required Purchase Order to **Falasca Mechanical** ; and the Administrator are hereby directed to authorize the Contractor to proceed with said work, all in accordance with their Proposal dated April 10 &14, 2020; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a Certificate of Available Funds has been issued by the Chief Financial Official and is attached to this Resolution as required by Law.
