## ESTABLISHMENT OF AN EMERGENCY 'NO PARKING' AREA OBERON AVENUE AND $24^{\text{TH}}$ AVENUE BETWEEN ATLANTIC AVENUE AND THE BAY

WHEREAS, the Borough of Longport Police Department will be participating in the POLICE UNITY TOUR that will involve numerous members of police departments throughout the United States and the world on Monday, May 10, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Unity Tour Chapter II was scheduled to depart for Washington, D.C., from Longport as part of the 2020 Police Unity Tour that was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The chapter has requested to depart from Longport for the 2021 Police Unity Tour; and

**WHEREAS**, in the interest of safety during this event, there is a need to declare an emergency "no parking" area on Oberon Avenue and on 24th Avenue between Atlantic Avenue and the Bay; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.3, a Municipality has the right to permit special traffic regulations when circumstances of this type dictate its necessity.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commissioners of the Borough of Longport that it hereinafter authorizes the following temporary, special traffic regulations to be implemented in the Borough of Longport, Atlantic County, New Jersey:
