

Water Tower Renovation Update— November 29, 2022

The emptying of the water tower has been completed and water service is now direct feed to homes and businesses. Residents might continue to experience fluctuations in water pressure and discoloration through the work period, which is expected to be completed by April 30, 2023.

If you experience any discoloration, please be aware that this is temporary and residents are advised to let the water run until it clears. Please take this into consideration when washing laundry, especially lighter colors.

If you experience a water emergency during regular business hours (Monday through Friday from 9 am to 4 pm) please contact the Longport Public Works Department at 609-823-2731 ext. 114. If you experience a water emergency after hours, please contact the Longport Police Department by calling 609-822-2141.

There are several areas throughout the Borough where residents might see water coming out from fire hydrants including: 33rd and Amherst avenues; 31st Avenue and the Public Works Building; 11 ½ Avenue Alley and Atlantic avenues; and Sunset and 30th avenues. Releasing water at times helps maintain necessary levels of water pressure.
